From Youth Chaplain's Desk

Dear Ascension Mar Thoma Church Family,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ-

Joni Eareckson Tada was a vibrant 17-year-old in 1967 when her life changed forever. An avid athlete, Joni loved to swim and ride horses. But one summer day, while diving into the Chesapeake Bay, she misjudged the water's depth and suffered a severe spinal cord injury, leaving her paralyzed from the shoulders down. In an instant, her entire life was turned upside down.

During her early days of rehabilitation, Joni struggled with deep depression, anger, and doubts about God. She could not imagine living the rest of her life as a quadriplegic, reliant on others for even the simplest tasks. But in the midst of her despair, she clung to her faith. Over time, she came to a powerful realization—that although she had lost her physical abilities, her life still had incredible purpose through God's grace. Despite her paralysis, Joni found new strength in the Lord. She began to use her artistic talents, painting by *bolding a brush between her teeth, and went on to write books, record music,* and become an advocate for people with disabilities. Today, Joni is a renowned author and speaker, sharing the message of God's love and the bobe that sustains ber.

Joni's story of faith and perseverance echoes the words of Isaiah 40:31: "Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint." As we journey through the months of October to December, we witness the change of seasons around us-the colorful transformation of autumn, the warmth of Thanksgiving gatherings, and the joyful anticipation of Christmas. Each season holds a special significance, inviting us to reflect on God's work in our lives.

As we step into the fall season, Joni's story reminds us that even in times of loss or struggle, God is still at work in our lives. The falling leaves remind us that some things may need to be released in order for God to bring new life. Like Joni, we may face seasons of difficulty, but through faith, we can trust that God is renewing our strength and shaping our future in ways we may not fully understand.

Thanksgiving is not just about the blessings we receive, but about acknowledging the strength God gives us to endure and grow.

Just as Joni found hope in God's promises during her darkest moments, we too are reminded that Christ's coming brings light to the darkness.
