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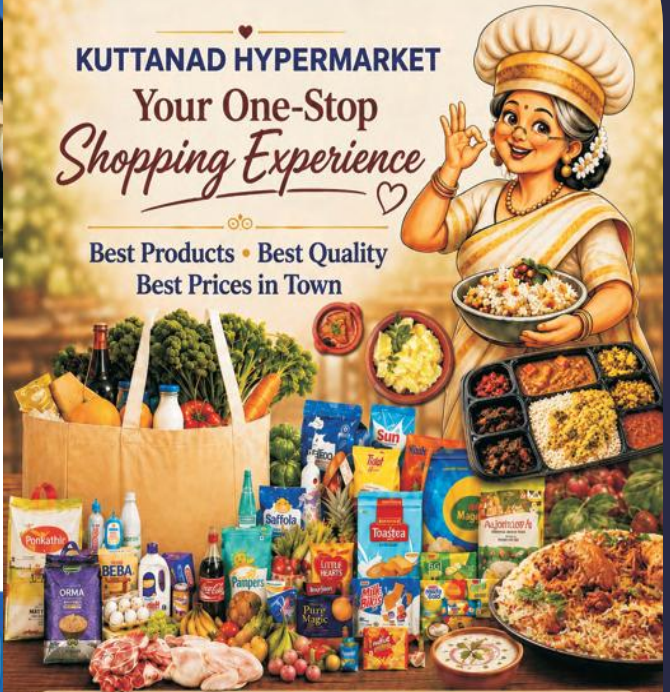

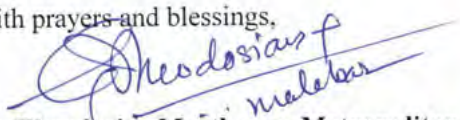

MESSAGE FROM **REV. ABRAHAM KURUVILLA** Youth Chaplain, Southeast Region Center B

The challenge of Romans 12:1–2 strikes at the very heart of what it means to grow up, find an identity, and live faithfully in a world that constantly demands our compliance. For the youth of the Malankara Mar Thoma Syrian Church, this tension is uniquely acute. We stand at a fascinating crossroads: navigating the rapid, secular shifts of modern culture while carrying the dual DNA of a church that is proudly Eastern and Reformed.

The Apostle Paul writes to the Romans with an urgent plea:

"Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect." (Romans 12:2)

To "conform" means to be poured into a mold. It is the path of least resistance. It happens when we let outside pressures shape our values, identity, and worth.

For today's youth, the molds of this world are incredibly sophisticated.

The Digital Mold: Algorithmic culture on TikTok, Instagram, and YouTube dictates what is beautiful, what is successful, and what is worthy of attention. It fosters a culture of comparison, where worth is measured in views, likes, and trends.

The Performance Mold: The intense pressure to succeed academically, professionally, and socially. The world tells you that you are what you achieve, leading to high anxiety, burnout, and a deep-seated fear of failure.

The Individualistic Mold: Modern society pushes a hyper-individualism that says, "Your truth is your own, look out for number one, and cut ties with anything old or demanding."

Conformity is easy because it is quiet. It doesn't require conviction; it only requires you to drift with the current. But Paul warns us that conforming to the age (*aeon*) we live in ultimately hollows us out, leaving us disconnected from God and from our true selves.

The Mar Thoma Identity: Eastern and Reformed

How do we resist this pressure? The answer lies in the beautiful, rich heritage of the Mar Thoma Church. Our identity is defined by a unique convergence: we are Eastern and Reformed.

1. The Eastern Heritage: Theosis and Liturgy

Our Eastern roots connect us to the ancient traditions of Saint Thomas. In the Eastern understanding, salvation is not just a legal transaction; it is Theosis—the lifelong process of becoming more like God, sharing in His divine nature through His grace.

When Romans 12 speaks of being "transformed" (*metamorphoo*—the same word used for Christ's Transfiguration), it aligns perfectly with this Eastern vision. Transformation isn't a

sudden, superficial behavioral shift. It is a deep, metabolic change where the light of Christ begins to shine through you.

2. The Reformed Principles: Scriptural Grounding and Openness to Truth

At the same time, the 19th-century reformation within our church—led by pioneering spirits like Abraham Malpan—infused our Eastern heritage with Reformed convictions.

The Reformed background empowers your mind. It insists that the "renewing of your mind" mentioned in Romans 12 involves critical thinking, engagement with scripture, and a conscious rejection of cultural idols—whether those idols are secular trends or dead, unmeaningful traditions.

Living Sacrifices

Transformation begins when we present our bodies as a "living sacrifice." In the ancient world, a sacrifice was something you killed and gave to God. A living sacrifice means giving your daily, active life to Him.

It means dedicating your career ambitions, your relationships, your social media presence, and your hidden thought life to Christ.

When you choose integrity over an easy shortcut at school or work, you are offering a living sacrifice.

When you choose to speak words of life and encouragement online rather than joining a toxic comment thread, you are resisting conformity.

A Call to Action

Youth of the Mar Thoma Church, you are not the church of tomorrow; you are the vibrant church of today. Do not let the secular world squeeze you into its mold, and do not let apathy rob you of your inheritance.

Look to your Eastern roots to find deep, contemplative anchors for your soul when the world gets too loud. Look to your Reformed roots to give you the courage, clarity, and biblical conviction to stand up for justice, truth, and love in a broken world.

Be transformed. Let Christ renew your mind, change your heart, and use your life to show the world a better, more beautiful way to live. Amen.

Built For More Than This Moment

"For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." Ephesians 2:10

I have always been fascinated by how God creates things. Fish swim. Birds fly. Trees grow toward the light. None of them need to be convinced to become what they were created to be because their design is already woven into them.

Human beings are different. We spend much of our lives trying to discover who we are. We wonder if we are enough. We compare ourselves to others. We question our purpose. We make mistakes. We succeed. We fail. And somewhere along the way, many of us begin believing that our worst moments define us.

Yet Scripture tells a different story.

Ephesians 2:10 reminds us that we are God's handiwork. Some translations say workmanship. Others say masterpiece. The image is the same: God is still creating, still shaping, and still forming. The beautiful thing about a masterpiece is that it is not completed in a single moment. It develops. It changes. It is refined. Sometimes the Artist adds a brushstroke. Sometimes He removes one. Sometimes what feels like a setback is actually part of the process.

The older I get, the more I realize that growth rarely happens when everything is going well. It often happens in the moments when God is teaching, redirecting, stretching, and refining us—not because He is against us, but because He is committed to us.

The world often measures people by a single chapter. God sees the entire story. Where we see failure, He sees formation. Where we see disappointment, He sees development. Where we see an ending, He sees a beginning.

That truth has given me tremendous hope.

It means that we do not have to be perfect to be used by God. It means that our mistakes do not have the final word. It means that every season—even the difficult ones—can become part of God's greater purpose.

As we gather for DYFC 2026, my prayer is that we remember this: You are more than your successes. You are more than your failures. You are more than the labels placed upon you by others. You are God's handiwork, and the God who began a good work in you has not stopped working.

There are still pages to be written. There is still growth ahead. There is still purpose unfolding. Because the same God who created us is still shaping us into all He intended us to be. Let's explore that together!

MESSAGE FROM CONVENERS

We live in a world that moves quickly.

Products are replaced when they stop working. Trends disappear as fast as they arrive. Mistakes are remembered, screenshots are saved, and people are often defined by their worst moments. Somewhere along the way, many of us begin to believe that if we fail enough times, we're less valuable. Less useful. Less worthy.

So we learn to hide.

We hide our weaknesses behind great achievements.

We hide our struggles behind smiles.

We hide the parts of ourselves that feel unfinished, hoping no one will notice the cracks.

Yet God has never been intimidated by unfinished things.

Throughout creation, growth has always been a process. Trees do not reach their full height overnight. Clay does not become a masterpiece the instant it touches the potter's wheel. The most beautiful things are often shaped through failure, patience, and time.

The same is true for us.

There are seasons in life when God seems to be stretching us beyond our comfort. Moments when old habits are challenged, attitudes are exposed, and our plans begin to look different than we expected. In those moments, it can be tempting to assume that something has gone wrong.

But what if those moments are not signs of God's absence? What if they are evidence of His attention?

The hands of a sculptor remain closest to the stone that is still being shaped. The gardener spends the most time tending the branches he intends to grow. The teacher invests in the student he knows can do more.

God does not walk away from what He loves. He works on it. The areas of our lives that feel uncomfortable, challenged, or refined are often the very places where God is doing His deepest work. Not because He is disappointed in us, but because He sees who we can become. This year's DYFC theme invites us to look at our lives through a different lens. To recognize that God's involvement in our lives is not a sign of rejection but of relationship. That His desire to shape us comes from love, not condemnation. That being challenged by God is not the same as being abandoned by Him. The truth is that every one of us is still becoming. Still growing, and still being shaped into the people God created us to be. And that process is not always easy. It requires humility, trust, and the ability to surrender the belief that our failures have the final word.

But the good news is this: God is not finished with us. The chapters we wish we could erase, the mistakes we wish we could undo, and the weaknesses we try to hide, none of them place us beyond His reach. Because the God who shapes is also the God who restores. The God who refines is also the God who remains. And the God who points out what needs to change is the same God who lovingly walks beside us through that change.

So as you journey through this conference, come with an open heart. You may discover that the places where He is working the most are not proof that you have been set aside.

They are proof that He is not done with you yet.

"My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, because the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and he chastens everyone he accepts as his son."

Hebrews 12:5–6

In today's culture, "canceling" has become increasingly prevalent. A single mistake or failure can quickly define a person, and grace often feels scarce. In such an environment, correction can easily be mistaken for rejection. There is a constant pressure to appear flawless rather than to grow honestly.

Hebrews 12:5-6 presents a profoundly different model. God does not cancel — he corrects. His discipline is not rooted in anger or dismissal, but in love and commitment. While culture may withdraw at the first sign of imperfection, God draws closer with purposeful refinement. His correction is evidence that we belong to Him and that He is invested in who we are becoming.

As we gather in Philadelphia — a city known as the City of Brotherly Love — this message carries even deeper significance. True love does not abandon when flaws are revealed; it guides, restores, and strengthens. Hebrews reminds us that genuine love is not the absence of correction but the presence of commitment.

In a world quick to cancel and slow to forgive, God models a love that corrects with purpose, sustains with patience, and never lets go. It is a powerful and necessary lesson for young people today — that mistakes do not define us, growth is always possible, and true love does not walk away when we fall short.



Conference Rules and Regulations – DYFC 2026

All participants are expected to adhere to the following rules and guidelines throughout the duration of the conference. The Ascension MTC Conference Committee reserves the right to update these rules and regulations as needed.

1. Attendance & Participation

Attendance and punctuality at all scheduled meetings, sessions, and activities are mandatory.

Participants are expected to actively engage and conduct themselves respectfully during all conference events.

2. Conduct & Behavior

Participants must treat fellow attendees, staff, clergy, and volunteers with respect at all times.

Any inappropriate behavior, including harassment, bullying, or disruptive conduct, will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action, including removal from the conference without refund.

Participants are expected to uphold and respect the faith, values, and practices of the Mar Thoma Syrian Church and Ascension Mar Thoma Church.

Electronic devices should be used respectfully and must not cause distractions during sessions or services.

3. Substance Policy

The use or possession of controlled substances (including drugs), alcohol, and vapes is strictly prohibited on conference grounds and hotel premises.

Violations may result in immediate dismissal from the conference without refund.

4. Housing & Curfew

Participants must stay in their assigned rooms and are not permitted to switch rooms without prior approval from the Conference Committee.

Participants are not permitted to enter rooms assigned to the opposite gender.

Participants acknowledge that housing will be assigned and agree to respect roommates and all housing rules.

All participants must be in their assigned rooms by 11 PM.

Quiet hours will be enforced from 12 PM to 6 AM.

Participants must adhere strictly to lights-out and quiet hours set by the Conference Committee.

5. Movement & Supervision

Participants must remain on conference premises at all times unless prior approval is granted by the Conference Conveners or designated officials.

Participants must sign out with a designated official if leaving the premises.

Participants may not loiter in or access unauthorized areas of the conference or hotel facilities.

6. Transportation

Transportation between the hotel and conference venue will be provided via buses and vans.

Participants must follow all instructions during transportation and remain with the group at all times.

The organizers are not responsible for individuals who miss scheduled transportation.

11. Enforcement

Failure to comply with any of the above rules may result in disciplinary action, including warnings, fines, or immediate removal from the conference without refund.

The Conference Committee reserves the right to enforce these rules as deemed necessary to ensure the safety and integrity of the event.

12. Name Tag & Identification

Participants must wear their conference name badges at all times during conference events.

13. Key / Room Access Responsibility

Participants are responsible for their room keys/access cards. Lost or damaged keys may incur a replacement fee.

14. Bible Requirement

Participants are expected to bring a physical Bible for use during sessions and worship.

15. Valuables Disclaimer

Participants are responsible for their personal belongings. The conference organizers are not responsible for lost, stolen, or misplaced items.

16. Membership Verification

The Ascension MTC Conference Registration team will be contacting parish Vicars to verify membership with the parish you are registering with. Your registration will not be final until your membership is verified.

17. Authority & Final Decision

Final decisions regarding rule enforcement may involve clergy (Achen) along with the Conference Committee.
